INTRODUCTORY ITEMS

AC:11:01	The Chairperson calls the House to order
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Minutes:

The quorum having been attained, the Chairperson declared the meeting open by welcoming the new members and by recording his deep appreciation of the invaluable contribution made by the Members of the First Academic Council in shaping the University as it stood today.

AC:11:02	Obituary Reference	
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Minutes:

Names of the eminent personalities and relations of members of family of employees of Sikkim University, who passed away recently, were read out. The House observed two minute silence as a mark of respect to the departed souls.

AC:11:03	Performance Highlights by the Vice-Chancellor
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Minutes:

In his 15 minutes power-point presentation, the Founding Vice Chancellor touched upon wide range of issues, from the students enrolment to award of degrees, curricular review to evaluation, recruitment of teaching and non-teaching positions, management of University administration under challenging circumstances, visits to affiliated colleges, engagement in community development programmes and NET-SLET examination. He observed that though much of his early expectations were frustrated owing to various extraneous causes, the University was able to pursue the academic programmes quite satisfactorily till date.

The members noted with appreciation the efforts made by the university to foster remarkable and all-round growth in trying situations and hoped that the same would continue unabated.

Minutes:

Minutes of the tenth and last meeting of First Academic Council held on 20.08.2011 was presented. It was reported that these minutes were duly circulated among members of the First Academic Council for their comments if any. Since no comment from any member was reportedly received, these minutes were confirmed.

Minutes:

Report of action taken on the directions of members on various items of agenda of the last meeting was presented. The members perused and approved the action of the university.

AC:11:06	Zero Semester Cases
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Minutes:

The members noted that applications of fourteen students, who had sought to avail the benefit of Zero Semester, for their end-semester examination of Monsoon 2011, were considered by the university. The House accorded its approval to the proposal.

AC:11:07	Unfair Means Cases
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Minutes:

The members perused the recommendations of the Examination Disciplinary Committee on the three cases of students, who were found to adopt unfair means in Monsoon Semester Examination 2011, and approved the same for necessary follow-up action.

AC:11:08	Semester Break Cases
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The members were apprised of the provision for permitting semester-break to students, who are forced to temporarily discontinue studies under compelling circumstances. Applications of thirteen such students received during Monsoon semester and recommended by the university were considered and approved.

AC:11:09	Improvement Cases for the Monsoon Semester 2011-12
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Minutes:

The members were informed that altogether 28 candidates of Monsoon semester examination 2011were found eligible for writing improvement papers as per the Ordinance framed. The House noted the matter with approval.

AC:11:10 Amendment to Ordinance on Examination – clause relating to "Zero Semester"

Minutes:

After detailed deliberations, the House unanimously adopted following amendments to the proposed Ordinance on Examination with regard to the provisions for Zero Semester Clause 05.13) by inserting following new proviso:

05:13 (3A): Provided that the student may also tender application in prescribed format duly recommended and forwarded by the Principal of the College / Head of the Department to the office of the Controller of Examinations within 7 (seven) days after the completion of the end – semester examinations in emergency / special situation like inevitable medical attention required due to sudden and severe illness, death in the family, accident involving the student herself or himself, while the examination is in progress.

<u>05:13 (3b):</u> Provided that in the event of a student availing Zero Semester in the same semester when she/he is also required to clear the improvement paper and cannot do so because of Zero Semester, shall clear the improvement paper without fail in the same designated semester when she / he is doing the Zero Semester.

<u>05:13 (3c):</u> Provided that students prosecuting programmes with courses having 8 semesters or more like B.A-LLB (10 Semesters), B.Sc. in Horticulture & Floriculture (8 Semesters), B. Pharm. (8 Semesters) may avail "Zero Semester" twice in the entire course subject to approval by the appropriate authority. However, the second Zero Semester can only be availed after the completion of the Sixth Semester and clear the Zero Semesater in the relevant (odd / even) semester after the completion of the final semester.

AC:11:11

Amendment to Ordinance on Examination – clause relating to "Pass requirements and promotion to the next semester."

Minutes:

The members noted that due to introduction of Choice-based-credit-system (CBCS), certain transitional difficulties with regard to pass requirements and promotion to next semester have arisen. In order to obviate those difficulties and to bring more clarity to the system, the House decided that

- (i) to insert two provisions to the first Ordinance on Examinations (as amended upto 20.08.2011) below Section 05.12(3) as follows
- 05:12 (3) (a): Candidates falling below this stipulation but maintaining minimum aggregate marks / grade specified for General Course candidates shall also be promoted to the next semester.
- 05:12 (3) (b): "A candidate who fails to score a cumulative aggregate of 40 per cent but secures at least 35 per cent cumulative aggregate when he / she completes the degree shall be demoted and shall be awarded a General Course degree".
- (ii) the stipulation of pre-CBCS syllabus for promotion to the next immediate semester should be allowed to continue and 2010 stipulation should b made effective from 2012-13 academic session at the undergraduate (affiliated college) level.

AC:11:12	Amendment to Examination Ordinance – Insertion of new Clause relating to Integrated Courses
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Members noted with appreciation that programmes offered under integrated courses in Sikkim University have increased from four to nine during the academic year 2012 – 13. It further noted that these programmes have provisions to exit after completion of undergraduate segment and also to permit lateral entry at the postgraduate level.

The House also approved introduction of oblique sign (like BA/MA) replacing hyphen sign (like BA-MA) in all the expressions of descriptions of courses.

Accordingly, relevant provisions under sub-section (h) of Section 05.15 of the Examination Ordinance have been permitted to be amended to read as under

AC:11:13	Amendment to Examination Ordinance – Insertion of new Sub-Clause relating to

Minutes:

11.13.1 The House considered the proposal under submission and approved insertion of new Sub-Clause regarding award of divisions / class to successful candidates in Sikkim University in general programme as under;

The House directed to bring the above proposal as amendment to the relevant provision in the First Ordinance on Examinations retrospectively covering Monsoon 2008 to till 2009-10 batches.

AC:11:14	Amendment to Ordinance on Examination – Award of division and award to topper
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Minutes:

The House after an exhaustive deliberation on the topic suggested the University to select the topper by calculating percentage out of the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

The House further directed to bring the above as amendment to the relevant provision in the First Ordinance on Examinations.

AC:11:15	Amendment to nomenclature of the programme: BA-MA Music.
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Minutes:

The House noted the proposal under submission and approved the UGC nomenclature of degree programmes in Music as Bachelor/Master of Performing Arts (Music) for implementation in the University.

In line to the above, the House directed to bring amendment in the relevant Ordinance(s).

AC:11:16 Amendment to M. Pharm. Syllabus: Paper MPY 31 (Biodiversity of Eastern Hima
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Minutes:

In view of the anomaly persisting in the credit allocation for Paper MPY 31 (Biodiversity in Eastern Himalayas) in M.Pharm syllabus, the House considered and approved implementation of the following pattern of evaluation and weight-age as follows;

AC:11:17	Amendment to M. Pharm. Syllabus: Paper MPY 33 (Dissertation) III & IV Sems.
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Minutes:

The Members noted the difficulty in distributing credits allocated for dissertation in Paper MPY 33 of M Pharm Syllabus of Third and fourth semester. It was decided that the results of paper MPY 33 will be declared only on completion of fourth and final semester.

AC:11:18	FIELD STUDY AT THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES: Amendment to payment norms.
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Minutes:

The Members were informed that Sikkim University has introduced a system under which the cost of field visits conducted by students as part of their undergraduate curricula is reimbursed to colleges. According to this, each student is paid @ Rs. 75 per day for a field trip of at least 12 days. In addition, a lump sum amount of Rs. 5000 is paid to respective college for ensuring smooth conduct of the field visit. It has been experienced that the Teacher Coordinators, who accompany the students are often required to spend for themselves, as there is no provision for reimbursement of their expenses.

The House, after detailed discussion and on obtaining views of the members representing affiliated colleges, directed that the lumpsum amount of Rs. 5000 be henceforth paid to the Teacher Coordinators for each trip. The amount should be shared, if more than one teacher is engaged. It was decided that the scheme would be reviewed to make it more effective.

AC:11:19 Report of Inspection Committee – Sikkim Government College

Minutes:

Members noted the observations of the Inspection Committee and noted that the college did not fulfill the minimum norm of permanent affiliation. The recommendation to continue with the provisional affiliation for the year 2012 – 13 was approved by the House.

The Vice Chancellor discussed the matter at length with the Members and urged upon the need for a serious relook into the performance of some of the affiliated colleges, which were erstwhile affiliated to the University of North Bengal. This was necessitated by growing apprehension of uncertainty on the one hand and non-improvement of academic infrastructure on the other. Members shared his concern and requested the Vice Chancellor to conduct a second and more comprehensive inspection of similarly placed colleges under the Chairmanship of Prof. Rajkishor Gupta, Member of the Academic Council.

- Discontinue courses on Science covering Bachelor's programme in Mathematics,
 Chemistry, Botany and Microbiology from academic year 2012-13 until further notification.
- iii. Grant Provisional Affiliation, limited to existing Arts and Commerce courses, for 2012-13.
- iv. Organise special inspection by the Inspection Committee headed by Prof. Gupta.

Accordingly, the proposal was accepted in principle, but its implementation is deferred until next academic year 2013-14, when formal permission may be considered subject to appointment of qualified teachers in respective subjects and setting up of laboratories. The college may be advised to that end and requested to make a fresh request when these are complied with.
